Introduction

This document presents select results from the EcoAnalytics Panoramic survey conducted in May–June 2018. The survey gauged public attitudes toward a broad range of issues of interest to progressive and environmentally-oriented organizations in Canada.

The tables included here summarize responses to specific questions for the total sample as well as for key demographic sub-groups. To read these effectively, you may wish to look first at the top row, titled “Total.” Here you will find the distribution of weighted responses (totals) for the entire sample by running your eye across this row. Rows beneath this line highlight the distribution of responses for particular socio-demographic sub-categories, allowing for comparison across these groups.

Further details summarizing the central tendency (mean), dispersion (standard deviation) and statistical significance of responses are found in the accompanying Excel file.

Results from the survey experiment testing narratives around the energy transition require a different form of analysis and are not included here. These will be presented in the 2018 Panoramic Analytical Report.

Methodology

The 2018 Panoramic survey was conducted online with 3000 Canadians aged 18 and over from May 25 to June 7, 2018. A random sample of panelists was invited to complete the survey from Research Now SSI (Survey Sampling International). The association representing market and survey research in Canada—the Marketing Research and Intelligence Association (MRIA)—advises that on-line panels in Canada are not considered probability samples. As such, a margin of error is not applicable.

To enhance representativeness, data are weighted in all tables to age, gender and region according to the latest population estimates from Statistics Canada. Totals may not add to 100 due to rounding.
